



Getting around in Antwerp

Are you looking for the fastest way to get to your meeting- or conference location? Or do you want to use your free time to go shopping or to visit a museum? In Antwerp, there's a lot of options to reach your destination. A bicycle, a taxi or even transport by waterway: discover all the possibilities.

On foot or by bike

Antwerp is a pocket-sized metropolis: most attractions, conference centers and hotels are close together. To give you an idea, it's a 25-minute walk from Antwerp's Central Station to the river Scheldt. Walking is the best way to experience and explore the city. Do you have a bicycle at your disposal? Then it's even faster.





Shared mobility

In Antwerp, you'll see a lot of residents and visitors using shared mobility. The Velo city bikes take you anywhere you want to be, they are available every day and every moment. The first half-hour of your rental is included in the price, if you use the bike longer, then you pay extra. Do you prefer using a scooter? Bird, Lime and Poppy provide free-floating shared scooters. They don't have a fixed parking space, you need an app to locate them. You can also use other shared mobility like car sharing.

Public transport

Is the weather not on your side? The buses, premetro's and trams of De Lijn will take you wherever you want to go. Buy your ticket at a newsstand, at the ticket machines at the stops or in the Visitor Centers. Did you park your car at the park-and-ride in Merksem, Luchtbal or Linkeroever? Then it's very easy to take a bus or a tram to Antwerp's city centre.

Tip: do you plan to visit many attractions and museums in Antwerp? Buy an **Antwerp City Card** and discover the best of Antwerp for free or with a significant discount. In addition, you **travel for free throughout the city, using trams and buses.**

Taxi

Need to get from point A to point B quickly? A taxi will bring you to your destination in a fast, safe and affordable manner. You pay a uniform tariff, controlled by the city and shown on the taximeter in the car. At Central Station, taxi drivers are waiting to transport you. Or use **www.taxi.eu** to order one.

Transport by waterway

Transport and sightseeing combined: Waterbus transports passengers (and their bicycles) across the Scheldt river, between Antwerp, Hemiksem and the port. The boat leaves every half an hour and it's easy to buy a ticket on board.
